


Instructions

According to Sec. 14-327b of the Connecticut General Statutes, "No distributor shall sell or offer to sell motor fuel in this state unless such distributor has first registered with the Department of Consumer Protection each type of motor fuel which he intends to sell and has received from the department a certificate of registration for each type of motor fuel which he intends to sell."

1. In the **Brand Name** block please provide the name as it appears on the dispenser, invoice or bill of lading for each Motor Fuel being registered. Diesel fuel should be indicated as either No. 1 or No. 2 fuel.
2. In the **Octane or Cetane** block please provide either the octane (R+m/2) or cetane number. All tests to determine the quality of gasoline or diesel fuel shall be made in accordance with the most recent revision of either Standard D439, Specification for Automotive Gasoline, or Standard D975, Specification for Diesel Fuel Oils, of Part 23 of the American Society for Testing and Materials.
3. In the **Type of Oxygenate** block all automotive gasoline or automotive gasoline-oxygenate blends containing at least 1.5 mass percent oxygen shall be identified as oxygenated fuels along with the predominant oxygenate in the engine fuel, such as but not limited to ethanol or MTBE.
